## **Why won't Pepsi let me vote when I click on [www.refresheverything.com/marineparents/](http://www.refresheverything.com/marineparents/)?**

You must register with Pepsi before you can vote. Go to [www.refresheverything.com](http://www.refresheverything.com) and click Join Refresh Everything on the blue bar at the bottom of the screen. Register your name and email. Once registered, the blue bar will say Welcome (your name) instead of Join Refresh Everything.

## **Once I register, will I receive spam e-mails from Pepsi?**

No, you will not receive any e-mails from Pepsi. If you would like, you can choose to receive updates from Pepsi, but you will only receive those updates if you choose to receive them.

## **How do I vote?**

Make sure you are registered with Pepsi Refresh, sign in, and then go to [www.refresheverything.com/marineparents/](http://www.refresheverything.com/marineparents/) to vote for Purple Heart Family Support. Click vote for this idea.

## **How often can I vote for Purple Heart Family Support?**

You can vote for Purple Heart Family Support once a day throughout the entire month of April.

## **Why can't I use all 10 of my votes for Purple Heart Family Support today?**

Pepsi gives you 10 votes for 10 different ideas each day. You can only vote for Purple Heart Family Support once daily. After that, you may use your other 9 votes for 9 other ideas. Although we encourage you to vote for other ideas, we would like to ask that you vote only for Purple Heart Family Support in the \$250,000 category.

## **Who can vote?**

All legal residents of the United States residing in one of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia who are 13 years of age and older.

## **How long is the competition?**

30 days! The competition lasts during the entire month of April so continue to vote and spread the word to friends, family, and members of organizations you may belong to.
